

## **2009 Wessex Centre Enduro Championship Rules**

The championship will be run under the following rules:

- The classes eligible for championship points will be Expert, Clubman, Clubman Over 40 and Trail & Trial.
- The title of 'Wessex Centre Enduro Champion' will be awarded to the best overall ride in the Expert class, as we do not currently run a Championship class. Winners of the Clubman, Clubman Over 40 and Trail & Trial classes will be acclaimed Centre (class) Enduro Champion.
- To be eligible for championship points, a competitor must be an affiliated member of a Wessex Centre club at least one month prior to the event.
- Tyres shall be as defined in the current ACU Standing Regulations.
- All machines should comply with the Enduro and Hare & Hounds Standing Regulations, where applicable to that event, as per the ACU handbook.
- All designated championship rounds count. If a round is cancelled its points will be deemed 'null and void'.
- Championship points will be awarded as per ACU Enduro Standing Regulations i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> – 20 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 17 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 15 points, 4<sup>th</sup> – 13 points, 5<sup>th</sup> – 11 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 10 points and so on until 15<sup>th</sup> – 1 point. Points will be awarded per class, per round. In the case of ties in the results of each day, the competitors concerned will each receive points for this position, e.g. Competitor A and B both finish the day on the same penalty points and competitor C on 820 penalty points the championship points will then be: A – 20, B – 20, C 15.
- The onus is on the rider to enter all championship rounds with no preferential treatment regarding entries and their acceptance given.
- To be eligible for championship points, a rider must contest 2 or more championship rounds.
