SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. **THE EVENT** will be held under the NSC of the ACU, the Standing Regulations of the ACU, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued by the club.
2. **ENTRIES** must be sent to the Secretary and will be accepted up to the closing date of MONDAY 1st SEPTEMBER 2008 or when full, if sooner. All entries must be accompanied by 4 stamped, self-addressed envelopes OR 4 self addressed sticky labels with stamps. The entry fee will only be returned if the event is cancelled or at the discretion of the Secretary, less an administration fee. Competitors should hold an annual competition licence or purchase a One Event licence.
3. **FEES** Entry £38 Full club membership £7 Day membership £4 One-Day Competition Licence £10
4. **THE COURSE** will be at Cirencester Park, Glos, all on private land. Lap distance will be approx. 10 - 12 miles over gravel & grass tracks & through woodland. Number of checks/laps subject to conditions on the day. The course will be clearly marked with arrows and tape. Drivers will be started in groups of 4 in numerical order at one-minute intervals. DEAD ENGINE START. First group will be started at 10 a.m.
5. **CLASSES**

Clubman Enduro – E1 – 100 cc– 125cc 2 stroke	175cc -250cc 4 stroke
E2 - 175cc – 250cc 2 stroke	290cc - 450cc 4 stroke
E3 - 290cc -500cc 2 stroke	475cc – 650cc 4 stroke

Sportsman

(Only one solo class may be entered.)

6. **AWARDS:** *Clubman:* Premier, Best in each class, Gold awards to Drivers losing up to 110% of the class winners penalties. Silver awards to drivers losing between 111% and 120% of the class winners' penalties. Awards to all other finishers. No one may win more than 1 individual award.

Sportsman: Award to all finishers.

7. **MACHINE EXAMINATION** Machines and clothing must be presented for examination not less than 1 hour before the drivers start time. Machines to be put into the Parc Ferme where working on them WILL NOT be permitted. Lighting on machines should work at all times. Helmets must be ACU approved and in GOOD CONDITION. Helmets not deemed to be in good condition may be confiscated for the duration of the event.

WORKING LIGHTS MUST BE FITTED TO ALL MACHINES

8. **TYRES:** Front tyre pattern: *unrestricted*. **THE REAR TYRE MUST CONFORM TO THE ACU APPROVED PATTERN FOR TRIALS. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this regulation at this Venue.**

9 **START:** Drivers should NOT enter the Closed Control more than 5 minutes before their due start time to wheel their machines to the Start line. On the start signal being given, Drivers must start their machines using the means provided and cross a line 10 metres away within 1 minute , under engine power. Drivers exceeding their 1 minute allowance may then start the machine by any means but must cross the start line before proceeding.

10 **TIMECHECKS:** The start will be a Timecheck. The times allowed between other checks will be displayed before the start. The onus of ensuring the correct arrival time rests with the Driver. Drivers must stop at every check and present their Time Card for marking. **Drivers may arrive early at the final check without penalty.** Details of the Special Test will be given in the Final Instructions.

11. **PENALTIES and EXCLUSIONS: As per ESR 26**

12. **GENERAL:** Competitors will fit riding numbers to machines

Please check your Final Instructions carefully for any further Regulations.

Refreshments will be available throughout the day. Please place all of your litter in the bins provided; better still take it home with you. The use of pressure washers is NOT permitted (ESR38). For your safety you are required to bring with you a Fire Extinguisher min 2kg (ESR37). **To preserve the events future, please keep off the Polo pitches.**
